

Maple syrup operation (January – March)

✓ 10430 St. Rt. 185, Covington Located along the Scenic Stillwater River, and offers very unique topography. Rolling hills stretch from the upland prairie through the woodland ravines and on to the Stillwater River. A large stand of mature maple trees provides sap for the on-site educational maple sugaring operation.
