New In 2016

Over the past few years the Miami County Park District (MCPD) parks have become a popular place for photographers. In an effort to accommodate the growing demand for these types of photos, while continuing to preserve valuable natural areas, we will be issuing Commercial Photography Permits to those who use MCPD property for profit.

When Is a Permit Required?

A permit is required if the photographer:

- Sells produced images
- Uses imagery for advertisement
- ✓ Is paid for services as a photographer while on MCPD property
- Uses large or unusual equipment while taking photographs which might interfere with programs or other park visitors

When Is a Permit Not Required?

A permit is not required for:

- Personal use to preserve memories and to share on social media
- Special occasion photography/videography that will be used only for personal enjoyment
- Members of the news media

Types of Permits

There are three types of Commercial Photography Permits available:

- ✓ Annual Unlimited \$100
- ✓ Single Use \$25
- Daily Video \$50
