4536 St. Rt, 202, Tipp City

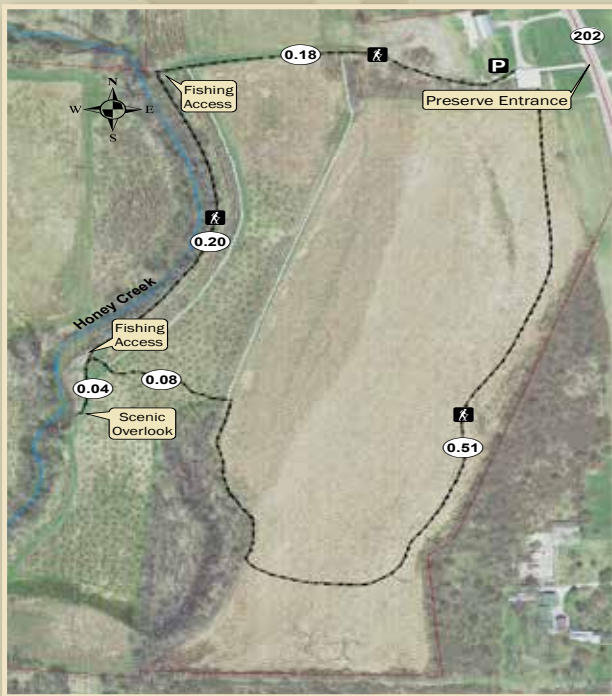

The park has a mile long nature trail that follows along Honey Creek, through a prairie, wetland and woodlands. The Great Miami River Recreational Trail is adjacent to this park.
