## Planting A Rainbow

If you are not able to plant a rainbow, take a walk around your neighborhood or park and find flowers all colors of the rainbow \& ones that match all the color chips in rainbow tool bag. ## Spring Things

In one week how many "Spring Things" from the book can you do? JOURNAL IDEA: draw/write them. Use magnifier to look closely at new plant buds. Use compass to see the direction wind or a rain storm is coming from. Use tweezers to pick up tiny seeds on the pavement and plant them in soil with shovel. PICTURE IDEA: Imagination Butterfly Band on your favorite sign of spring!

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## The Surprise Garden

Ask someone to give you a variety of seeds or find wild seeds to plant a surprise garden! Use shovel to help plant. Use tweezers to pick up seeds \& look at size \& shapes with magnifier or in magnifying box. How many different colored seeds match color chips in rainbow tool bag? After garden grows, use measuring tape to find longest \& tallest plant! Have a garden party!
