1. **FLIPGRID:** Take a video of an animal in its Habitat (home) in your yard. Show and explain on the video the animal, what the animal needs to survive: its food, shelter and explain where it might get water. (SEE **FLIPGRID Mini Science Challenge: Backyard Animals**)
2. Take a few minutes to find an animal, animal home, or some other sign that an animal has been there. A good place to look is under logs, rocks, trees and tall grasses.
3. Draw a picture of the animal and the animal's habitat. Be sure to include and label everything that provides what the animal needs in their habitat.
