



The Case For Belonging...

Belonging leads to a 75% decrease in sick days amongst staff


Belonging Impacts Well-Being 78%

Of those who feel like they belong rated their well-being favorably.

28% Of those who feel like they **don't** belong rated their well-being favorably

The lack of a sense of belonging can also cause stress, depression and anxiety. These can initiate a vicious cycle of selfdestructive behaviors that further prevent a person from belonging.

Relational

Ensure a sense of belonging no matter where people are working.

Physical

Adopt best practices that support peoples' physical well-being.

Purposeful

Evolve the organization's purpose to meet an enlightened workforce, customer and community.

Create reward and benefits packages that meet people's evolving needs.

Employable

Equip people with the right adjacent skillsets to transition into higher paying jobs and new roles.



We must get the basics right

- 1. Onboarding Experience
- 2. Respect https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=PYJ22-YYNW8
- 3. Take Action on Feedback examples shelter process, hot days, sick days, refunds, etc.
- 4. Recognition ask for examples
- 5. Everyday Experiences = 5X increase in NBO scores
- 6. Moments that Matter = 4.3X increase in NBO scores

Personal Relationships

- Create space to openly bring viewpoints without hesitation
- Encourage healthy discussion
- Demonstrate trust and respect
- Take a genuine interest in colleagues and staff
- Celebrate successes and offer support through challenges
- Create psychologically safe spaces (activity ideas & handout)
