A. Staff Reports

- a. Operations - Dan distributed photos of current projects. He said Lost Creek Reserve has substantial tree damage, including trees that were likely over 250 years old. There were also many trees along the bikeway from St. Rt. 202 to the Troy Foundation bridge.

Dan spoke about an injury that occurred on the trail at Charleston Falls Preserve and recognized Susan for the outstanding job she did assisting the injured individual until emergency personnel arrived.

- b. Marketing - Amanda had no addition to her written report.
- c. Environmental Education - Susan said the Zip & Climb Adventure wrapped up last weekend for 2026. The Fishing Derby had 168 participants on September 13. School programming has started and there are new schools participating this year. Susan is reaching out to additional schools still. The Outdoor Adventure Club is in the on-boarding process.
- d. Executive - Scott will attend the September 30 meeting concerning the Grid Growth in Miami County. The park did receive a notice from the Grid Growth but is unsure which property it is in reference to.
