## Craft/Costume (individual classrooms) (50 minutes) Insect Hat & Sign

Materials:

Headbands 22" long x 2-3/4" wide tag board strips (1 per student) (provided by teachers)
Bridge for headband 12" long x 2-3/4" wide tag board strips (1 per student) (provided by teachers)
Tag Boards 8-1/2" x 11" (1 per student) (provided by teachers)
Paint Sticks (1 per student)
Copies of head, thorax, abdomen printed on tagboard (1 set per student)
Craft materials – such as various colors of construction paper, feathers, material, yarn, buttons, sequins, pipe cleaners, etc. (provided by teachers and MCPD)
Sticky Foam Insects (3 per student)

Instructions for Insect Hat & Sign:

- Using the tag board head, thorax, and abdomen as a base to build upon, students will be creating a 3D insect (imaginary or real) that must have a head, thorax, abdomen, 6 legs, and a mouth (chewing, cutting, piercing, sucking, etc.) to attach to the Bridge on their Headband.
- Students will make a Sign using the 8-1/2" x 11" and paint stick that says "WALK WITH CARE".
- 1. Pass out copies of head, thorax, and abdomen set.
- 2. Pass out one 8-1/2" x 11" tag board square for each student.
- 3. Give students one paint stick and 3 sticky foam insects for their sign.
- 4. Show examples of costume hats. Show example signs that say "WALK WITH CARE".
- 5. Help students create their costume.

Insect Hat:

- 1. Cut out head, thorax, and abdomen
- 2. Staple these to the Bridge
- 3. Create an insect using the cut outs as a base. Encourage the students to build up their insect to make it 3D by using the craft materials available.
- 4. Wrap the headband around the student's head to measure for the correct size then staple the headband together.
- 5. Attach the Bridge with the completed insect to the headband.

Sign:

- 1. Have student take off one shoe and place their foot on the 8-1/2" x 11" tag board Sign.
- 2. Trace around student's foot.
- 3. Student will write on the Sign with markers or crayon in large, bold, letters "WALK WITH CARE".
- 4. Student will color in the footprint.
- 5. They will attach 3 sticky foam insects if available. If not, they can draw and/or create 3 insects using the craft materials available and attach to the Sign to make it 3D.
- 6. Staple paint stick to the back of the Sign so the student can hold the Sign up high.
