### CHEF HAT

#### **MATERIALS NEEDED - Per Student**

☐ Straws (1 piece per student)	☐ Poster board for headbands (1 per student)(provided by teacher
☐ Seeds (3 per student)	☐ Poster board for tag board (1 per student)(provided by teacher)
☐ Stapler & staples	☐ Plant parts patterns (1 page per student)
$\square$ Clear tape (to secure the seeds)	☐ Pictures of jobs (1 page per student)


#### **CHEF HAT:**


- 1. Cut 28 x 22 inch pieces of poster board lengthwise into strips, 2-3/4" wide for headbands. (1 strip per student).
- 2. Cut  $28 \times 22$  inch pieces of poster board lengthwise in half for the tag board. (1/2 per student).
- 3. Staple tag board to headband.
- 4. Give each student 1 copy of plant parts patterns and 1 copy of pictures of the jobs of each plant part, along with a straw and 3 seeds.
- 5. Students should write their names, "Chef (their name)," on the headband of their hat. The naturalist and teacher can measure heads while students finish names and begin the first part.
- 6. Do each plant part together as a large group. When a student finishes the current plant part they can place it off to the side and begin to decorate their hat until the next plant part is called. The students need to make sure their hats have Sun, Soil, Water, and Air in the decorations.
- 7. Have students put their initials on the back of ALL plant parts before they color or cut any of them out.
- 8. Start with the root. Do the verse and have the kids figure out which picture represents the carrot and what the job of this root will be. Review all 'jobs'- picture or prop (straw, or seeds). Once chosen, they should color (can be done messy) and cut out the carrot. Then have them cut out the picture of the job (if necessary) and paste to the front of the plant part. Do this with each of the plant parts.

**DO NOT COLOR THE JOB PICTURES** so that they will stand out more. When students get to the Flower, they have the choice to keep the cauliflower white and color the job picture or vice versa. . . but they can only color one or the other. **NOT BOTH.** 



- 9. The hat decorations need to be complete and all plant parts need to be complete before the plant parts are glued onto the chef hat.
- 10. Adjust the hat to fit around the child's head and staple it together.
