SESSION 1: THE BIG 3: AND HOW THEY WERE FORMED

During this 20 minute online adventure, your naturalists will lead the session from one of our many Miami County Parks! We will introduce igneous, metamorphic, and sedimentary rocks, along with some of the common places to find each type on Earth. Using demonstrations, explorations will be made to see how each type of rock has its own process to follow in forming.
