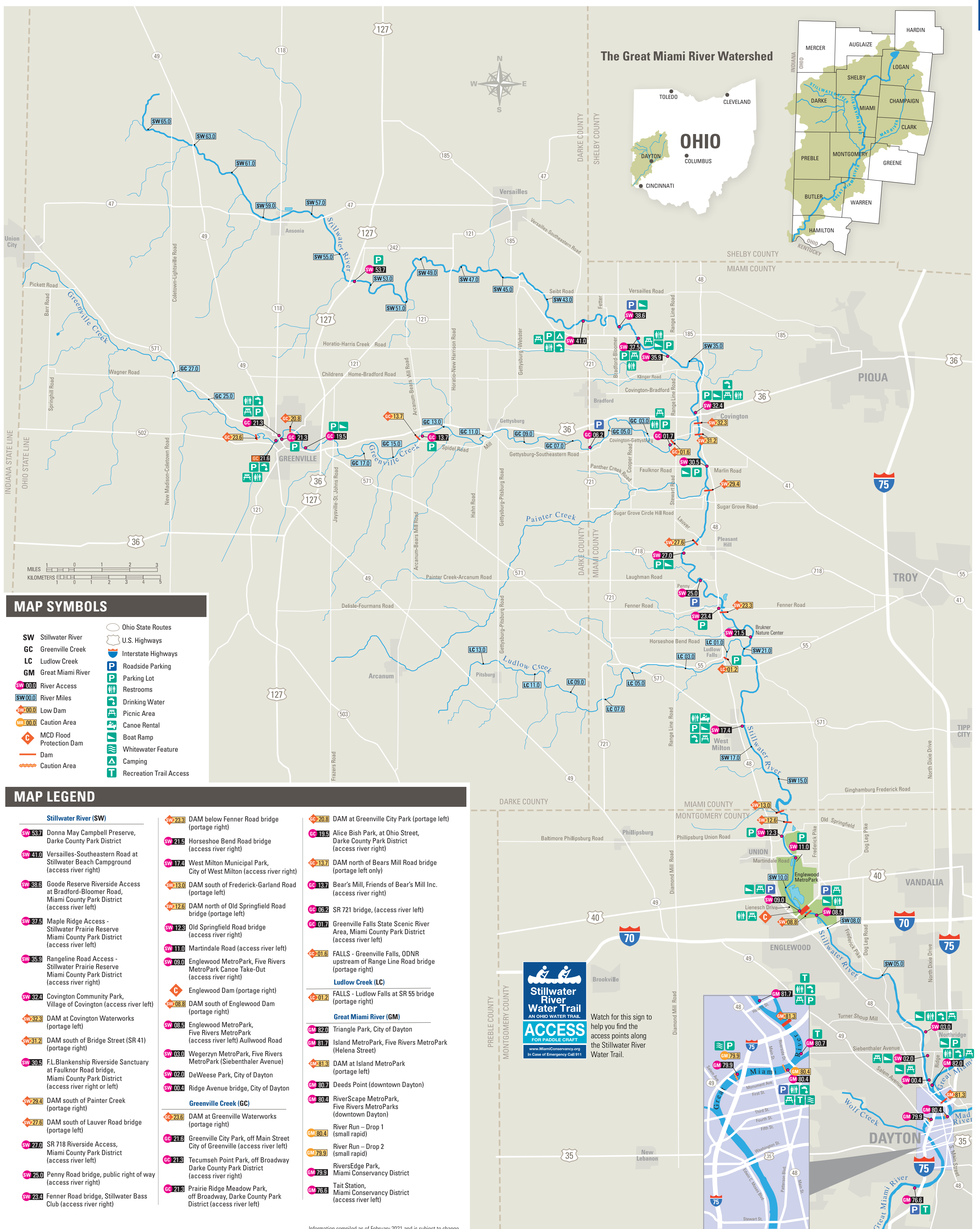


# Stillwater River
